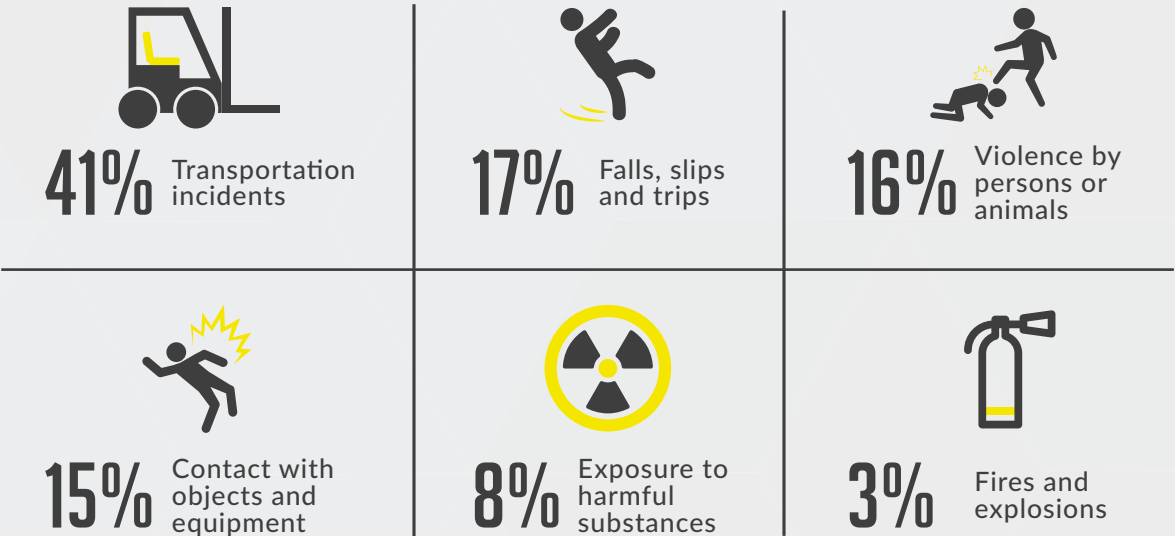

CATEGORIZED BY MAJOR EVENT



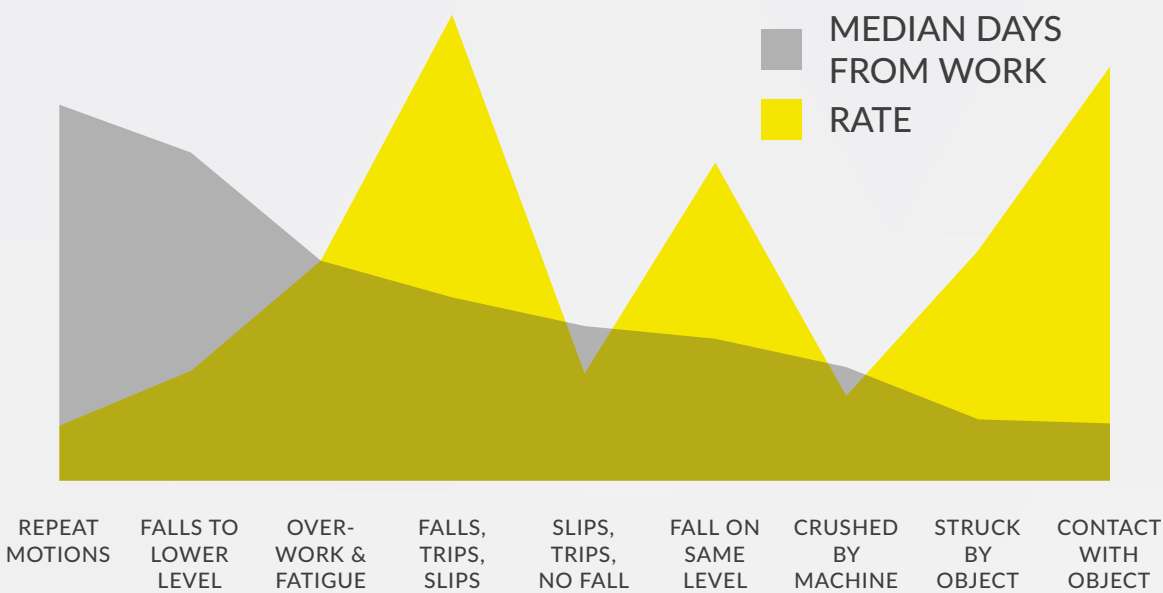
RATE OF FATAL WORK INJURIES

Properly train employees on a regular basis

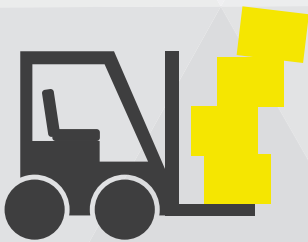


Use & inspect safety equipment & tools



Install barriers and gates to direct traffic

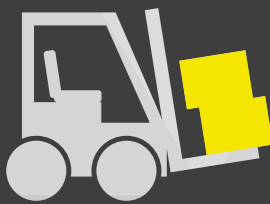
FORK TRUCK SAFETY PRACTICES



Only handle loads within the fork truck's rated capacity



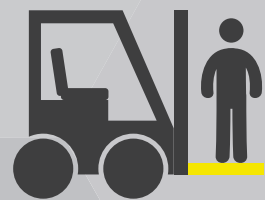
Only trained & certified individuals should operate fork trucks



Always tilt the load back before raising or driving the fork truck



Never walk under a raised load. Watch for pedestrians!



Never allow riders on the forklift



Always wear a seatbelt!
